Internal Application Deadline: August 30, 2020

Program Description: The Johnson & Johnson Scholars Award Program aims to fuel development of female STEM²D leaders and feed the STEM²D talent pipeline by awarding and sponsoring women at critical points in their careers, in each of the STEM²D disciplines: Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Manufacturing and Design.

FAQs, Sub-category Classification, and Program General Terms

Budget: \$50,000 direct costs per year for 3 years; no indirect costs.

Number of Applications: 1 per STEM²D discipline

Eligibility:

- Non-tenured females who are in Assistant Professor / Instructor faculty positions.
- Have a Ph.D. or equivalent in one of the appropriate fields (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Manufacturing, Design).

Required Documents:

Internal submissions must contain information in the following order in a single PDF document:

1. A 1,000-word outline (plus one page of images) detailing your proposed area of research.
2. Applicant's resume (three pages, font size 11), including a list of publications, presentations, abstracts, current financial support already obtained, other folio work and two references.
3. A brief outline of a budget for the proposed research. (Note: a [template](#) is provided if needed.)

Please use the following naming convention: PI last name-first initial_J&J2021.pdf (Example: Smith-J_J&J2021.pdf).

Selected candidate will require a 1- to 2-page letter of nomination (from Department Chair/Division Head) detailing why the candidate should be considered. The nomination letter should clearly state to which of the six STEM²D disciplines the applicant is applying.
